- ◆ Challenges even motivated students

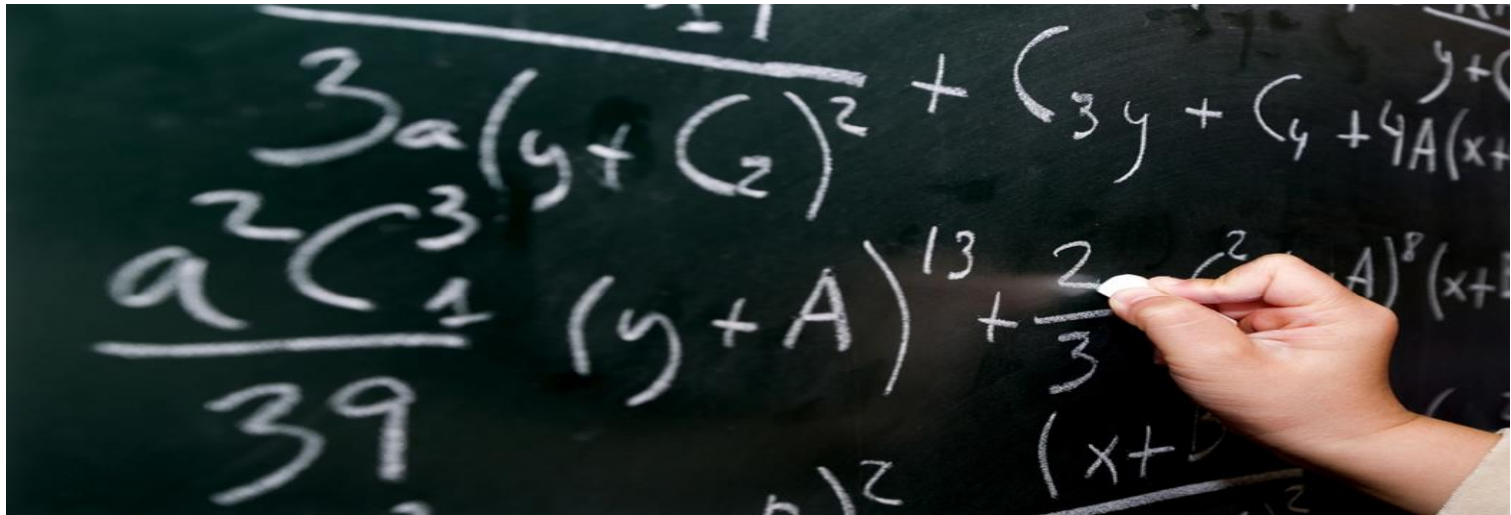


Who Should Take Pre-AP Courses?

- ◆ We expect much more of secondary students. Successful Pre-AP students will need to spend more time on homework, research, and outside class participation.

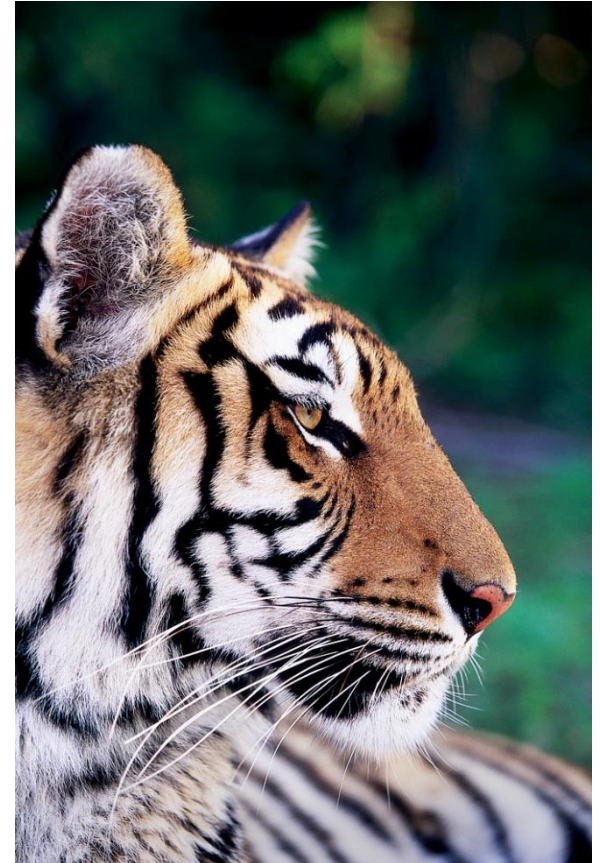
Math Placement

- Pre-Algebra for 6th grade Level math – skipping 1 year of math
- Benchmarks, Common Assessments, final average, STAAR
- Algebra 1: Summer Acceleration Course or Credit by Exam
